3.4 Equipment

There are 7 competition areas, these are fully equipped with electronic scoreboard systems and plasma screens.

Daedo PSS + E-Helmets (electronic body protector and E-helmet)

The Electronic body protector will be provided for all divisions by the organizing committee. The E-helmet will only be provided for classes where head contact is allowed.

PLEASE NOTE: CLASSES WITH NO HEAD CONTACT MUST PROVIDE THEIR OWN HEAD PROTECTOR.

#### 8.2 First Aid

Will be provided by the organization and are only to be used in case of emergency.

#### 8.3 Coach

For every 5 contestants within the same team, one coach is granted free admission, with a maximum of 6 coaches. Only competitors and coaches have admittance to the competition areas.

**Coaching is only allowed in sportswear. All coaches must 18 years or older.**

#### 8.4 Equipment

WTF-recognized gear and groin, forearm and shin protector, which are compulsory, will be brought by the contestants. Tooth protectors are compulsory! **E-Foot protection is compulsory for all competitors and will NOT be provided by the organization committee.**

#### 8.5 Protest

Only the official coach is allowed to protest, **immediately** after the end of the contest. An amount of € 50,00 (Euro) will have to be paid for each protest and will be returned if the protest was found valid. The decision of the judge is final.
